Business Referrals - Professional staff answers phone calls and accommodates thousands of visitors and residents each year, referring them to Chamber members for their product and service needs.

Check-Alert System - A service offered only to members whereby the police notify the Chamber of illegal check-writing activity and we notify participating Chamber members.

Chamber Newsletters - The chamber's printed newsletter is distributed to over 300 businesses quarterly, and the e-newsletter is sent twice a month to over 350 e-mail addresses. Members can include business news by taking advantage of advertisement and insert opportunities.

Bulk-Mail Permit - Members can use the Chamber's bulk mail permit to save money on mass mailings. Contact our office for details and instructions if your business is interested in this service.

Chamber Business Events - Quarterly and Bi-Annual Networking opportunities for member businesses.

Powell Bucks - A gift certificate program that keeps shopping dollars in Powell.

Retail Promotions - The Chamber works to develop programs that encourage residents and visitors to "shop Powell", and hosts a Powell, Wyoming booth at area expos and home shows to promote member businesses.

Community Resource Center - The Chamber serves as **the** distribution point for Powell Valley information. Information is available on upcoming community events, products and services available in Powell, demographic & relocation information, clubs and organizations, and more.

Inquiry Reports - Each month the Chamber provides a list of people who have requested relocation information to subscribing Chamber members.

Meeting Room - The chamber office has a well equipped, comfortable meeting room that can accommodate meetings of up to 15 people. The meeting room has a large dry erase board, a TV/VCR, and an overhead projector. Additional equipment is available on request.

Business Contact Lists - The Chamber office maintains both a list of member businesses and a more complete community business list both alphabetically and by category. Lists are available to chamber members in various formats.

Business Advocacy - The Chamber serves as the voice of small business locally and at the state and national level.

Business Display - Brochure, flyer and business card display areas are available at the Chamber building and at Chamber events.

Ribbon Cuttings - The Ambassador committee provides ribbon cuttings for new businesses, and for business expansion and relocation celebrations.

Meeting Recruitment - The Chamber's Conference and Visitor's Bureau committee recruits meetings, conferences, and tour groups to Powell to bring in outside revenue.

Training, Advice, Assistance - The chamber is a professional business organization that offers training, advice, and assistance to businesses of ALL sizes and types.

Powell, Wyoming Website - The Chamber maintains the Powell, Wyoming website. The site includes up-to-date, comprehensive information about member businesses, a community calendar of events, and visitor and relocation information.
